The robust form of this chair relates to those provided for the Neues Palais, Potsdam, in the 1760's. This decorated armchair with green and gold-painted wood is thought to be Potsdam, 19th Century.

The serpentined and medallion-backed fauteuil, with shell cartouches and scalloped enrichments merged with Roman acanthus, relates to the mid-18th century "Rocaillen" furniture patterns published in Augsburg by Johann Georg Hertel.
